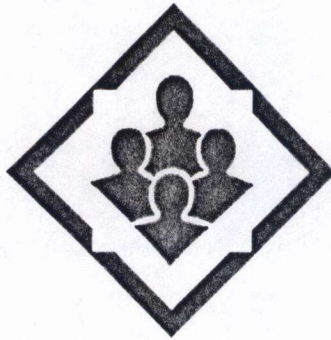

FINAL ARRANGEMENTS

Each group needs to prepare their own means of identifying themselves e.g. through wearing a uniform or name on a cardboard sheet.


4. Refreshments will be available although you will have to pay for alcoholic drinks from the bar.

Description of Group:

Family Service Unit is a national independant social work organisation with the aim of preventing family breakdown and supporting families within the community. The Thurrock Unit has been in existence for 10 years.

To achieve its broad aims the Thurrock Unit employs a range of services including: Family work, child sexual assault work, community work, children's holidays, drop-ins, playgroup, group work and an anti-bullying worker on a six months pilot project.

Examples where FSU may provide support include is where there are issues of difficulties in relationships, behavioural problems, sexual abuse, domestic violence, preventing family breakdown and financial problems. Over 50% of those we work with refer themselves to us and we only work with them on their agreement.

This Council owned building has been on the risk register for a number of years. In March this year a lease was granted to "Purfleet Heritage". The building has been made safe and new security door fitted. As part of the lease agreement, Thurrock Council will be undertaking essential repairs externally before the Heritage Centre is officially opened.
